ABOUT THE COMPANY

With a Bachelor of Science in Dance Kinesiology and Psychology from Texas A&M, Evelyn has since performed freelance and company work many choreographers, including Jane Weiner, Jee Uhn Ahn, Mark Dendy, Rod Rodgers, Monica Hogan, Lydia Hance, and Isadora Duncan. As Founder and Artistic Director for Spaces of Fontana, her choreography has performed all of the country, for MNN TV Station and been in residency at high schools in New York and Texas. Currently, Evelyn is performing with Smashworks Dance Collective and 'SHE' by Jinah Parker.

Ashley McQueen, Artistic Director of Smashworks, graduated with a BFA in Dance from Webster University and is currently pursuing her MFA in Dance from Hollins University. While in St. Louis, she performed with Common Thread Contemporary Dance and was twice invited by ANNONYArts to independently choreograph and direct two evening length concerts. As a Kranzberg Exhibition Series Guest Artist, she choreographed Laune, a site-specific dance performance on rideable lawnmowers for Laumeier Sculpture Park.
